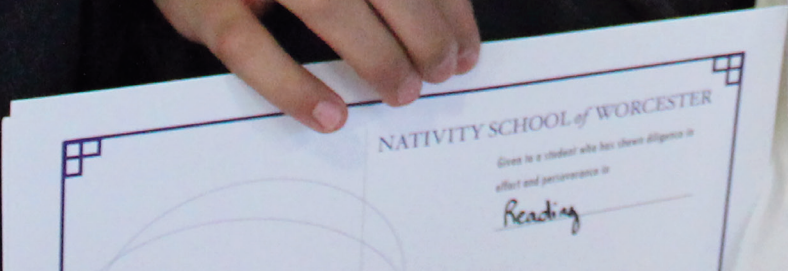

## Change that Lasts for A Lifetime

Dear Friends,

In a recent letter to Nativity School of Worcester supporters, João Vickttor De Carvalho, member of the Xavier Class of 2007 and a graduate of New Caanan High School through the ABC Program and the College of the Holy Cross Class of 2015, wrote the following as part of his reflection:

*“My experience at Nativity Worcester has been entirely positive and supportive. I’m always in awe at how this school continues to have an impact on my life years after I graduated. Whether you’ve been supporting us from the beginning, or whether you’re just hearing about our school, I want to thank you for your faith and support in Nativity Worcester. I can easily say that I wouldn’t be where I am today had I not gone to Nativity Worcester. Just as importantly, this school wouldn’t be what it is today without you. Thank you!”*

I could not think of any better way to describe what happens under the roof of 67 Lincoln Street, as I sat down to write this reflection to thank you for your support of our boys, our school, and our mission. Here at Nativity Worcester, we firmly believe that the circumstances into which you are born should not determine the trajectory of your life. At the time our students apply for admission, their families are looking for a fighting chance at a better life, hoping their son can achieve more than they have, and break a cycle of poverty which permeates so many aspects of their daily life.

Over the past 15 years, we have seen the aspirations of our students and their families come true in many different forms – full-tuition scholarships to private high schools, honor roll placements, earning a starting position on the varsity football team, college credits earned through scores on Advanced Placement Exams, a plumbing apprenticeship, earning a college diploma in four years, summer internships, and even landing that dream job at a large, Worcester-based employer – all catalysts towards the ultimate goal of a financially stable future. All this success affirms the development and determination of our students, our families, our teachers, our staff, and our supporters.

The 2016-2017 school year was filled with many successes for all our Nativity Men as you will see outlined in the report that follows. On behalf of the entire Nativity Worcester community, I’d like to extend my deepest gratitude to all of those who have contributed to the mission of Nativity School of Worcester over the past year. Last year, over 850 donors contributed a record-setting \$1.3M. We cannot thank you enough for your commitment to our boys and their future.

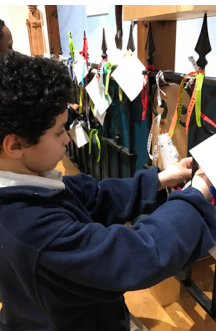

## ROSEND'S GRADUATION SPEECH

Good Afternoon. My name is Rosend Peña and I would like to say thank you for everyone who is here today. It means a lot to all of us that you are here with us.

"WOW". We finally did it. It has been a long four years, but we overcame obstacles and embraced challenges, and look where we are now - about to graduate Nativity School of Worcester and move on to high school. Think about how long 4 years is. When my classmates and I started Nativity, President Obama was just starting his second term; The Hunger Games Catching Fire was flying off the shelves at bookstores and Stephen Curry was not popular. There are 17,280 hours in four school years - and this doesn't even include summer session! That's 1,036,800 Minutes and that is A LOT of time.

It's only natural that being at this school for such a long time would lead to a huge transformation in all of us. As my fellow classmates put it, we all had "glow ups." A "glow up" is when you go from looking pretty unattractive to looking pretty good. We all made transformations physically, but let's talk about our emotional transformations. When I started at Nativity, I wasn't very good about caring for anyone else. I was really just focused on myself. At my old school, I just did my work and then left. I would do the work that would give me an average grade and I never truly pushed myself. When I

enrolled into Nativity, "average work" didn't cut it. My first grade for math in fifth grade was a D. Thank you, Mrs. Savage. This grade made me think to myself "I actually have to try now?" For a while I was mad and frustrated, but now that I have reflected and talked to others about this, I realized 3 major things.

First: I was lazy when I started Nativity.  
Second: I realized I am not as smart as I thought I was. Lastly, and thank goodness based on my first two realizations(!), I realized that Nativity actually cares so much about its students.. Our teachers want us to do better and know we can do better - and if we aren't doing our best, we earn bad grades. They push us to our limits and teach us things that will help us in the future - both about academic subjects and about just being good people.

Over my four years, I have learned to be a man for others. I have experienced successes and I have faced challenges. One success is when I got into Bancroft. Some of my challenges are when I fell off the stage in our 6th grade play. I have also ripped my pants, not once, not twice, but three times. The third time was this year but I managed to keep it hidden.

My classmates have also been through a lot. Personal struggles and achieving goals they never thought were going to happen. For example,

Jaiden spoke at the Clark fundraising event earlier this year and there were more people than you can count. My other classmate, Theo, was accepted to Noble and Greenough, a school only one other graduate from Nativity has gone to. We cannot forget the game where Robert scored 30 or when our basketball team went to a triple overtime in a championship game. We cannot forget the funny jokes that Jason and Jeff and Naethan M make or how Jyandriel earned High Honors with Distinction twice in one year. And how Thaddeus can read 10 books in one day while I am still in the first chapter of mine. Or how Henry can destroy anyone in any video game ever created. Our class has accomplished a lot; 'great' sometimes feels 'normal' to us, and I hope that continues.

Throughout all of our experiences at Nativity Worcester, we were also given something that many people do not get in a lifetime. We all now have at least 13 brothers. We all care for each other and are excited for one another. My classmates and I have a lot of challenges ahead of us, but we will not give up and we will support one another. To our future schools and to anyone with whom we will cross paths in the future - be ready for us - we are going to do great things.

# YEAR END AWARDS CEREMONY



On Monday, June 8, Nativity School of Worcester held its annual year-end Pillar awards ceremony. The Vires Award is given to the students who show exceptional strength during their time at Nativity Worcester. This student faces struggles head-on, and doesn't shy away from a challenge. The Mores Award was presented to Anthony Rodriguez-Mejia, Ikunza Class of 2017 and Rusty Lee Agyemang, Ricci Class of 2019. The Mores Award is given to the students who display exceptional character and distinguish themselves with qualities of honesty, politeness, and fairness to others. The Christianitas Award was presented to Dashawn Davis, Ikunza Class of 2017 and Meffi Herrera, Anchieta Class of 2018. This award is given to the students who show exceptional dedication to service both inside and outside of the school and who never hesitate to put others before them. The Studium Award was presented to Theo Kyenkyenhene, Ikunza Class of 2017, Bernard Santos, Anchieta Class of 2018, Denzel Martinez, Ricci Class of 2019 and Vyce Tetteh, Espinal Class of 2020. The Studium Award goes to the student who shows the greatest dedication to scholarship by displaying intellectual curiosity and a drive for academic success. The Spirit Award is awarded during the graduation ceremony to a member of the eighth grade class who has exemplified what it means to be a Nativity Man on countless occasions during his time at Nativity Worcester. This year's recipient was Rosend Peña, Ikunza Class of 2017.

## SUMMER OF SERVICE 2017

Nativity School of Worcester supplements our school year's education with a mandatory summer session. During the month of July, Nativity Worcester faculty, staff, and students return for three weeks of classes, field trips, and a comprehensive service-learning program. During service-learning, students reach out into the city and surrounding area through an integrated academic and community-service-oriented program. Nativity Worcester purposely plans our Summer of Service session to expose students to a wider variety of experiences than the traditional school year allows.

The mornings begin with language arts and math classes, which help our students improve and excel in core academic subjects before the traditional school year begins. Students that are struggling in language arts and math are able to make significant improvements as a result of additional time spent in the classroom and personalized instruction from our faculty. The faculty is also able to challenge students that are excelling in these subject areas to ensure they reach their full potential.

Students also participate in an integrated academic and community-service-oriented program. Students take a service-learning class where they learn about current and local issues affecting our community. In the afternoons, students and faculty volunteer at local organizations related to the topics they are learning about in the service-learning class. The goal of the service-based learning is to engage students in projects that not only teach them valuable, curriculum-linked lessons, but also empower them to recognize the ways they can improve their community.

This year's summer session quote was the following quote from Muhammad Ali: *"Service to others is the rent you pay for your room here on earth."* fifth - seventh grade students rotate through three service-learning sites, while the 8th graders take part in their own program, the Youth Philanthropy Initiative. In 2017, these fifth - seventh grade sites included: Dismas House, an organization aimed at reconciling former prisoners to society, and society to former prisoners, through the development of a supportive community; Park Spirit, a small nonprofit made up of dedicated board members and volunteers who seek to protect, to promote, to enhance, and to advocate for Worcester City Parks for all individuals to enjoy these public resources; and YouthGrow, an urban agriculture-focused youth development and employment program for low-income teens. For the eighth consecutive year, the eighth grade students had the opportunity to work on the Highland Street Foundation's Youth Philanthropy Initiative. Students working on this project learn about philanthropy and nonprofit organizations in their service learning classes. They reflect on their own personal values to determine what community services they deem most important for the people within Worcester. The students then choose how to disburse the \$5,000 of grant funds to four organizations. In 2017, the eighth graders worked specifically with Community Harvest Project, National Education for Assistance Dog Services (NEADS), the Unaccompanied Minors Program by Ascentria Care Alliance and the Latency Bridge Program at YOU, Inc. The Nativity Worcester community completed over 1,360 hours of service in the greater Worcester community during the 2017 Summer of Service.

# FELLOWS GRADUATION



This year, four Nativity Teaching Fellows, including one Nativity Worcester graduate, concluded their two years of service at Nativity School of Worcester. We are very grateful to them for their dedication to our students, their families, and our mission.

João Vickttor De Carvalho is a member of the Xavier Class of 2007 and is a graduate of New Caanan High School through the ABC Program and the College of the Holy Cross Class of 2015. Joveto served as an intern during Nativity Worcester's Summer of Service in 2014. He was part of the 6th grade team during his fellowship. In addition to his teaching responsibilities, Joveto served as one of the 7th and 8th grade basketball coaches and Evening Study Tutor Coordinator. He is currently working at Baystate Hospital in Palmer, MA.

Originally from New Jersey, Kyle Flanagan is a graduate of the College of the Holy Cross Class of 2015. He was part of the 8th grade team during his fellowship. Kyle served as the Advancement Associate, was an advisor to after-school clubs like the Career club, and helped coach the 7th and 8th grade basketball team. Kyle is now working for the Chelsea Public Schools system as an 8th grade English teacher.

Patrick Kerrigan is a graduate of the College of the Holy Cross Class of 2015. He received his M.B.A from Assumption College during his fellowship. Pat was on the 5th grade teaching team and served as the School Events Assistant and helped coach the 7th and 8th grade basketball team along with Joveto and Kyle. Patrick is now working at KIPP Academy Boston Middle School.

A graduate of Saint Michael's College Class of 2015, Amanda Souza is currently teaching at Achievement First Charter School in Hartford, CT. She held different roles during her time at Nativity Worcester, including serving on the 7th grade team, recycling club coordinator, activities coordinator and coaching the 5th and 6th grade basketball team. Additionally, Amanda worked with a volunteer and several students to help maintain the community garden.

# GRADUATE SUPPORT PROGRAM

Nativity Worcester is committed to the success of its students not only in middle school, but also in high school and college as well, through guidance, tutoring and financial support. Staffed by a Director of High School Placement, Director of College Placement and Transition and an Assistant Director of Advancement/Corporate and Community Outreach, Nativity Worcester's Graduate Support Program meets the growing and diverse needs of our graduates. We provide a safe and quiet space for homework help or schoolwork, high school transition and completion support, a new mentoring program, after-school and summer job search assistance, program events and community service opportunities, college search and financial aid application support. The Joanne and Brian McClatchy Graduate support room is a dedicated space on campus that functions as a safe haven for program participants looking to use computers for research, receive tutoring, or work on school assignments in a space conducive to learning.

Nativity School of Worcester has graduated 157 students 12 classes. Twelve (12) successful classes of Nativity Worcester graduates have matriculated into the following high schools: Assabet Valley Technical High School, Bancroft School, Burncoat High School, Cheshire Academy, CT, Claremont Academy, Cornerstone Charter Academy (FL), Deerfield Academy, Doherty Memorial High School, Masconomet Regional High School, Gardner High School, Holy Name Central Catholic Junior-Senior High School, New Canaan High School (CT), Noble & Greenough, North High School, Oldmar Christian School (FL), Saint Mary's Junior/Senior High School, Saint Peter-Marian Junior-Senior High School, Saint John's High School, South High School, South High School – Goddard Scholars Program, South Salem High School (OR), University Park Campus School, Worcester Academy, Worcester Technical High School, and Xavier High School (IA).

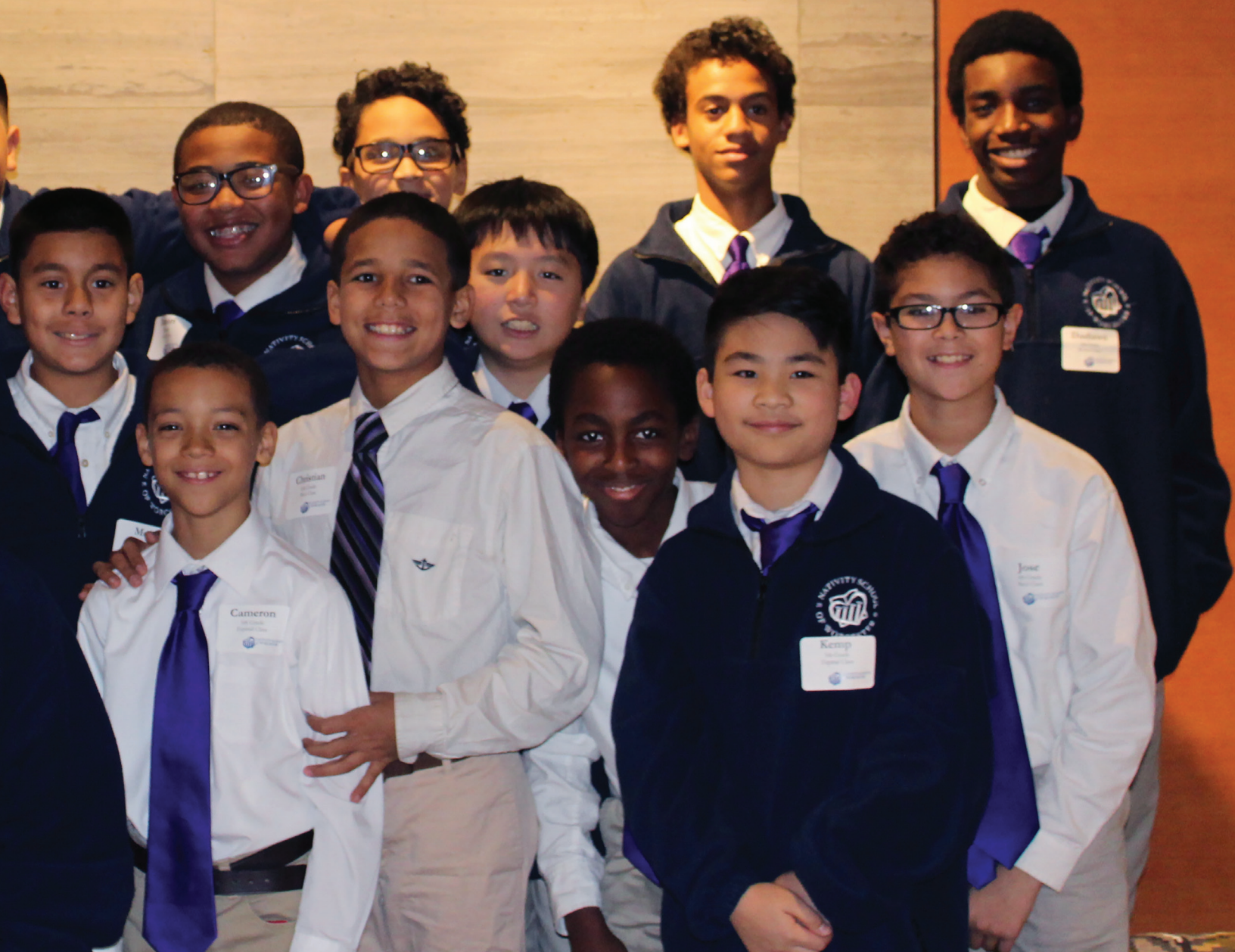

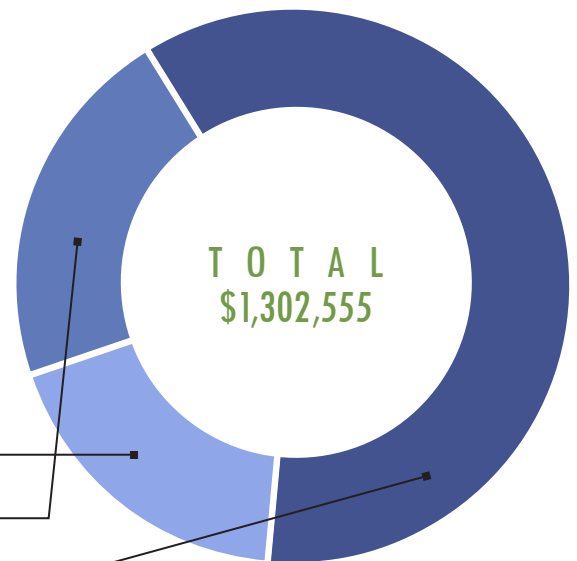

- One-hundred percent (100%) of Nativity Worcester's graduates who applied to a 4-year college or university or specialized post-high school program, were accepted to at least one school.
- Ninety-five percent (95%) of Nativity Worcester's graduates have graduated from high school or a specialized high school program (compared to the national high school graduation average of 75% for male students from low-income homes)
- Four (4) Nativity Worcester graduates have attained a graduate degree or are in the process of attaining one.

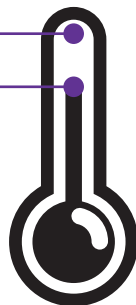

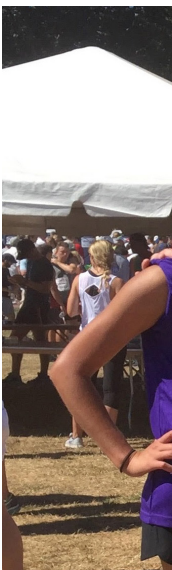
