LETTER TO OUR COMMUNITY

WHAT MORE CAN BE DONE?

The Society of Jesus (Jesuits) have a term, “magis”, which is a Latin adverb meaning “more” or “to a greater degree”. It is closely related to the Jesuit motto: “For the greater glory of God” and is a reminder to us all to strive to make the widest positive impact on those around us each and every day. I’ve experienced this concept firsthand at Nativty School of Worcester. For five years, I’ve worked at Nativty School of Worcester and marveled at the work that is done by our faculty, staff, and volunteers. Their commitment to our students, graduates, families, and each other is unwavering no matter how simple or complex the obstacle, they dive in head first to develop a solution. But that positive impact does not begin and end within the walls of 67 Lincoln Street – it flows freely out of our doors and into the Worcester community. It even reaches outside of the city. Word of a school community where collaboration permeates everything we do, no matter what your role is, the great individual care that is given to graduates, and the successes that our students have had inside and outside of their classroom has traveled far. And yet, despite all this good, I still find myself asking that same question - what more can be done?

At Nativty Worcester, there is no settling, no perfect or good enough. I believe that our path was best articulated in one of the decrees that came from 34th General Congregation of the Society of Jesus in 1995, namely, “We are never content with the status quo, the known, the tried, the already existing. We are constantly driven to discover, redefine, and reach out for the magis. For us, frontiers and boundaries are not obstacles or ends, but new challenges



to be faced, new opportunities to be welcomed. Indeed, ours is a holy boldness, ‘a certain apostolic aggressivity,’ typical of our way of proceeding. Our way of proceeding is a way of challenge.” That’s the thread you should see running through the pages of this book. The faces you see in these photos are of people working hard to break the cycle of poverty for themselves, their families, or for others, and by doing so lift up our entire community. All the while, they are asking themselves what more they can do, what could they do better?

Our school is in a transitional period with its leadership, and I have been blessed with the opportunity to serve in the role of interim president for this year. I’m excited about all of the possibilities and can promise you that no matter what happens, I will give my all and do my best for myself, my family and for this entire community. As we move into a new academic year, I want to especially thank two members of our staff who personified the magis during their time with us. First and foremost, outgoing President Alex Zequeira. Almost 15 years ago, Alex first learned about this new school and became one of the key architects in establishing its culture and curriculum. Over the last five years, he has led our community with unlimited energy and has been a true champion for our students. As he takes over the helm at Saint John’s, I know that he will continue to advocate for our Nativty Men. Also, Benjamin Gitkind is departing after 6 years at the school. Serving as both a teaching fellow and a lead teacher, we are indebted to Mr. Gitkind for the talent he brought to school every class period, every Knight Time rehearsal, every arts night, and every baseball game.

As you will see in the pages that follow, there is a great deal to celebrate over the past year, and beginning with our Summer of Service, a lot of excitement about the coming academic year. Of course, there is also more that can be done for the future of Nativty School of Worcester. Under our Board of Trustee’s leadership and guidance, we’ve begun expanding the scope of our graduate support program to extend beyond college graduation to include career readiness. We are committed to our Nativty Men for the long term. We’ve already had great success with internship and job placements, and I encourage you to read more on page 12, and think about becoming involved with our efforts yourself. There is much more to be done, and we look forward to sharing all of the news with you as it happens.

YEAR END AWARDS CEREMONY

01, 02 On Monday, June 6, Nativity School of Worcester held its year-end awards ceremony. At this event, which begins the week leading to graduation, the school's faculty and staff present awards to students in all grades that best reflect the four pillars of strength (vires), character (mores), service (christianitas), and scholarship (studium). Awards are given for three of the pillars to one student from the eighth grade, and one student from the fifth-, sixth-, or seventh-grade, while the final pillar award of scholarship is presented to one student from all four classes. The Vires Award was given to Josephus Kiyee, Brooks Class of 2016 and Enock Oduro, Anchieta Class of 2018. The Vires Award is given to a student who shows exceptional strength during their time at Nativity Worcester. This student faces struggles head-on, and doesn't shy away from a challenge. The Mores Award was presented to A.J. Agemang, Brooks Class of 2016 and Alan Rivera-Lopez, Anchieta Class of 2018. The Mores Award is given to students who display exceptional character and distinguish themselves with qualities of honesty, politeness, and fairness to others. The Christianitas Award was presented to Tahjeek Clayton, Brooks Class of 2016 and Rosend Peña, Ikunza Class of 2017. This award is given to students who show exceptional dedication to service both inside and outside of the school and who never hesitate to put others before them. The Studium Award was presented to Denzel Martinez, Ricci Class of 2019, Bernard Santos, Anchieta Class of 2018, Theo Kyenkyenhene, Ikunza Class of 2017, and Prince Collins, Brooks Class of 2016. The Studium Award goes to the student who shows the greatest dedication to scholarship by displaying intellectual curiosity and a drive for academic success. Congratulations to all of this year's award winners!

SUMMER OF SERVICE 2016

03, 04, 05, 08 Nativity School of Worcester supplements our school year's education with a mandatory summer session. During the month of July, Nativity Worcester faculty, staff, and students return for three weeks of classes, field trips, and a comprehensive service-learning program. During service-learning, students reach out into the city and surrounding area through an integrated academic and community service-oriented program. Nativity Worcester purposely plans the Summer of Service

session to expose students to a wider variety of experiences than the traditional school year allows.

The mornings begin with language arts and math classes, which help our students improve and excel in core academic subjects before the traditional school year begins. Students that are struggling in language arts and math are able to make significant improvements as a result of additional time spent in the classroom and personalized instruction from our faculty. The faculty is also able to challenge students that are excelling in these subject areas to ensure they reach their full potential.

Students also participate in an integrated academic and community service-oriented program. Students take a service-learning class where they learn about current and local issues affecting our community. In the afternoons, students and faculty volunteer at local organizations related to the topics they are learning about in the service-learning class. The goal of the service-based learning is to engage students in projects that not only teach them valuable, curriculum-linked lessons, but also empower them to recognize the ways they can improve their community.

For 5-7th graders, students rotate through three service-learning sites, while the 8th graders take part in their own program, the Youth Philanthropy Initiative. In 2016, these 5-7th graders' sites included The Mustard Seed, a food pantry where students learned about food insecurity, hunger, and the importance of a healthy diet. Our students painted the back porch and basement walls of the pantry building, along with benches outside. The students also had the opportunity to visit the Community Harvest Project, where they learned how volunteers grow fresh fruits and vegetables to provide to those experiencing hunger in Worcester. The students helped harvest vegetables, and washed and packaged the food. At the third site, Worcester Common Ground, the students learned about the importance of community, improving neighborhoods, and affordable housing. The Nativity Men cleaned the grounds of their Tot Lot playground, Fatty Jenkins basketball court, Peace Park, and Castle Street Gardens, and added artwork and murals to surrounding neighborhoods.

For the eighth consecutive year, the eighth grade students had the opportunity to work on the Highland Street Foundation's Youth Philanthropy Initiative. Students working on this project learn

about philanthropy and nonprofit organizations in their service learning classes. They reflect on their own personal values to determine what community services they deem most important for the people within Worcester. The students then choose how to disburse the \$5,000 of grant funds to four organizations. In 2016, the eighth graders worked specifically with Friends of the Worcester Public Library, Ascentria New Lands Farm, Why Me & Sherry's House, and Salvation Army Citadel - Sally's Place. Over the course of the Summer of Service 2016, the Nativity Worcester community completed over 1,350 hours of service in the greater Worcester community.

FELLOWS GRADUATION

06, 07, 09, 10 This year, four Nativity Teaching Fellows, including two Nativity Worcester graduates, concluded their two years of service at Nativity School of Worcester. We are very grateful to them for their dedication to our students, their families, and our mission.

Juainer Beato-Lopez is a member of the Nativity Worcester Ignatius Class of 2006. He was born in the Dominican Republic, moved to Worcester at the age of 8, and has been residing in Worcester ever since. After becoming part of the first graduating class at Nativity Worcester, he graduated from Saint John's High School and then Providence College, with a BA in Social Science. Aside from teaching, he also served as Advancement Assistant and a basketball coach, while pursuing his Master's Degree in Business Administration at Assumption College. Juan became the first Nativity Worcester graduate to attain an advanced degree in May 2016 when he received his MBA. Juan will be moving on to the Hanover Insurance Group here in Worcester as a financial analyst.

Originally from Hanover, Massachusetts, Grace Gallagher graduated from Siena College in 2014 with a B.A. in English and a minor in psychology. During her junior year, she studied abroad at University College at Cork, Ireland. Grace served as a member of the 5th grade team for both years at Nativity Worcester. She also served as a PTA Coordinator and soccer coach. She completed a Master of Arts in Teaching at Clark University in May and will be teaching next year at University Park Campus School in Worcester.

Lisa L. Hua joined the Nativity Worcester community in the summer of 2013 as a summer intern. After a year, Lisa re-joined Nativity Worcester as a 2014-2016 Nativity Fellow. She graduated from the College of the Holy Cross in 2014 with a BA in Chinese and a minor in Chemistry. While at Holy Cross, she was an active Residence Assistant in first-year residence halls for 2 years and Head Residence Assistant in her senior year. She studied abroad in Beijing, China focusing on language and culture with a multimedia research project surrounding the Chinese educational system. Lisa earned her M.A.T. from Clark University, and certification in middle school mathematics and science in the spring of 2016. Next year, Lisa will be a science teacher at UP Academy Kennedy Middle School in Springfield, Massachusetts.

Jacob Kelley was also a member of the Ignatius Class at Nativity Worcester. After graduating from Saint John's High School in Shrewsbury, Jacob earned the Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship to attend Providence College in Rhode Island. He graduated in 2014 with a B.A. in Sociology and a minor in Black Studies. While teaching at Nativity Worcester, he also served as basketball coach for the 7th and 8th grade team during the 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 seasons. Over the last six months of his fellowship, Jacob also served in the Office of Graduate Support at Nativity Worcester assisting high school seniors through the college selection process. He is currently pursuing a degree in Community Development and Planning from Clark University, while also working at the Boys & Girls Club of Worcester.

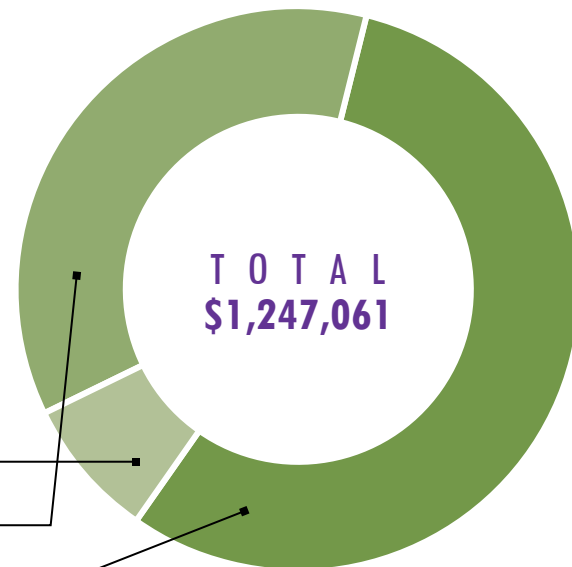

- \$1,247,061 was given to the Fund, which is the highest fundraising year in the school's history, and the fifth year in a row surpassing \$1.1 million.
- For the second year in a row, over 750 donors made a gift to Nativity Worcester.
- Students and faculty performed over 1,350 hours of community service in Worcester during the Summer of Service in July 2016.
- The Brooks Class of 2016 graduated in June and graduates enrolled at Bancroft School, Doherty Memorial High School, Holy Name Central Catholic High School, Saint John's High School, St. Mary's Junior-Senior High School, Worcester Academy, Worcester Technical High School, and Xavier High School (IA).
- Members of the Campion Class of 2012 have the following post-secondary plans: Assumption College, College of the Holy Cross, Johnson & Wales University, Johnson & Wales University - North Miami, Molloy College, Quinsigamond Community College, St. John's University, University of Massachusetts - Amherst, and Westfield State University. One member of the Campion Class will be starting his full-time plumbing apprenticeship this fall.
- Three members of the Faber Class of 2008 received their college degrees in 2016 from Providence College, Oregon State University, and Southern Adventist University.

- One member of the Ignatius Class of 2006 became the first Nativity Worcester graduate to attain a Master's Degree from Assumption College.
- One-hundred percent (100%) of Nativity Worcester's graduates who applied to private high schools were accepted into and received sufficient financial aid to attend at least one school.
- One-hundred percent (100%) of Nativity Worcester's high school aged graduates are enrolled in high school or a specialized high school program.
- One-hundred percent (100%) of Nativity Worcester's graduates who applied to a 4-year college or university or specialized post-high school program, were accepted.

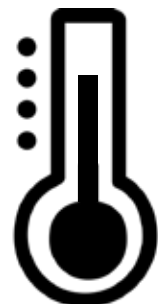
